

Cell Phone Use Policy

In order to provide an optimum environment for using the library, patrons are to turn cell phones, audible pagers and similar devices to the lowest noise level/vibrate when entering the library.

When possible, make and take all calls outside the building.

When using your cell phone, voices need be kept low as the sound carries through the library. Patrons are also to respect others by keeping conversations at low level and of short duration (less than five (5) minutes).

If such calls disturb other patrons, callers will be asked to go outside the building.

All of the above will apply to regular and hands free cell phones.
